The group got 4400 Glow bracelets on Friday April 29<sup>th</sup> and spent Saturday afternoon sorting them into groups of 10, so that on Monday May 2<sup>nd</sup> they could be passed out to all Students and Staff in the 3 high schools in Hamilton. Each person received and wore the bracelets for the day and throughout the week to bring awareness to the Overdose Prevention Act.

The Overdose Prevention Act", provides immunity to a person that calls 911 during an active overdose. It was signed into law on May 2, 2013. (Sometimes known as the Good Samaritan act)

The bracelets were donated by the Mercer County Prosecutor, Angelo J. Onofri.
